## SHOW RULES

1. Children's classes are eligible **only** to children of the appropriate age.
2. All other classes are open to everyone (including children).
3. Entry forms must be placed in the boxes at Goose Slade Farm Shop or Village Café, or sent to the ECFS c/o 21 Mill Close, BA22 9LF
4. Entries must be submitted by 1pm on the WEDNESDAY prior to the show. PLEASE NOTE: NO LATE ENTRIES CAN BE ACCEPTED.
5. All exhibits to be staged between 8.30am and 11am and to remain staged until 4.15pm.
6. Exhibitors to provide their own dishes, etc.
7. All exhibits **must** be the work of the exhibitor. Cut flowers, fruit and vegetables to be the growth of his/her own garden, except for Floral Display classes. Violation brings a ban for this and future shows.
8. Only one entry per exhibitor per class allowed.
9. No exhibitor shall be allowed in the room during judging, unless authorised by the Committee.
10. Points for trophies: 1<sup>st</sup> – 5; 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3; 3<sup>rd</sup> – 2.
11. The Maudslay Silver Challenge Cup will be awarded to the individual exhibitor gaining most points in the show.
12. All trophies will be held for 1 year and must be returned 2 weeks prior to the show. Exhibitors to engrave the cup with their name. Trophies remain the property of the Show Committee
13. The decision of the judges shall be final and the decision of the Committee in all other matters connected with the show shall be final.
14. An auction of produce will take place at 4.30pm. Any produce remaining at this time will be assumed to be available for auction, unless clearly marked "NOT FOR SALE".
15. The East Coker Flower Show accepts no liability or responsibility for loss or damage to any exhibitor's property, how-so-ever caused.
16. By entering, exhibitors agree to the use of their personal data which will be used solely for Show administration purposes. No information will be passed to third parties.
17. The judges are guided by the RHS for flowers/plants and NAWB for beer & wine.

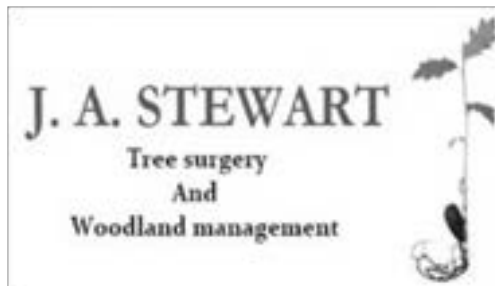

# HOME CRAFT

**Drake Memorial Cup**

Judge: Mr D Cunningham

**(No trade mark jars or lids - 12/16 oz jar unless stated otherwise)**

All entries to be presented **cold, on a plate and covered** (cling film or similar)

48	Courgette and lime cake Ingredients - 200g Light brown sugar, 200ml Vegetable oil (plus extra for tin), 4 eggs, 175g S/R flour, ½ tsp baking powder, 75g ground pistachios. 2 limes zested and juiced 1 medium courgette (grated and squeezed) Combine Sugar, oil and eggs in a large bowl and mix well; Fold in flour, baking powder and ground pistachios; add the grated courgettes along with the lime zest and half the juice; mix to combine. Bake in a 900g loaf tin lined with baking parchment at 180c/160c fan/gas 4 for 40-50 mins Leave to cool in the tin before transferring to a wire rack to cool completely before adding the frosting of: 275g soft cheese, 100g icing sugar, 1 lime zested and juiced, 25g shelled pistachios roughly chopped.
